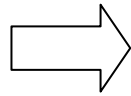

The Summer Program offers several opportunities for students including:

- Retaking a high school course previously failed (providing the student's attendance was in accord with the existing policy)
- Retaking a previously failed Regents (pending permission from the student's principal)
- Participation in a middle level program for invited students in Math
- A ten day Regents Prep Course for students who have passed the course and need to retake the exam

Registration:

- Registration is completed with the Guidance Counselor.
- There is no fee for Oceanside residents.
- There may be a requirement for tutoring if you are registering to take an exam only.
- Identification will be checked on the day of the exam.

Please note the following:

- *Only students who are Oceanside Residents* and attend any public, private or parochial school may register for the high school program with the written approval of their home school principal.
- All questions concerning residency will be determined by the District Administration in accordance with current policy.

SUMMER SCHOOL POLICIES

ATTENDANCE

The following will be strictly enforced so that credit is earned in compliance with New York State Education Department regulations.

There will be no exceptions.

All students must attend all class sessions and have no more than 2 absences. **On the third absence the student will no longer be eligible to take a State exam and jeopardizes earning credit for the course.**

A student who is not in the classroom within the first 15 minutes will be considered absent for the day. **Two latenesses of less than 15 minutes will be considered as one complete absence.**

It is imperative that students and parents plan for the full 23 days of class attendance in order to obtain credit and a seat for a State exam.

PARENT NOTIFICATION

Parents will be notified by telephone in the case of absences, excessive lateness, or improper conduct. Progress reports will be mailed home during the third week of summer school. A final report will be sent home and to a student's home school after final examinations. Parents may call at any time during school hours if they wish to be informed about academic progress.

COURSE AND EXAM GRADES

All students will receive a final report card. A copy will be sent to the home school where it will be entered onto the student's transcript. For Oceanside High School students, previous grades for a course are **not** removed from a transcript. Course grades are not recalculated based upon grades earned in summer school. The higher course grade, however, is used for calculating the student's cumulative high school average. *Non-Oceanside HS students* should consult with their guidance counselors prior to enrolling as to the way in which earned credit will be used at the home school.

CONDUCT

Rules of conduct for Summer School are the same as those for school throughout the school year in accordance with all policies included in the Oceanside Student Handbook. Each pupil is expected to be serious about his/her work and put forth effort consistent with ability. Lack of serious application to work or breaches of discipline may result in withdrawal from Summer School.

Students are to observe the same dress code as set for regular sessions. Footwear must be worn in the building at all times. Students may be sent home for inappropriate attire. (This will count as an absence.)

Students may not loiter in the parking lot, anywhere on the school grounds, or in front of our neighbors' homes.

Smoking (including e-cigarettes) is **not** permitted at any time in the school building or on school grounds. Violators may face suspension.

Students who drive to school must register their plate numbers in the office and park only in designated areas. All vehicles should be secured. There is no attendant in the parking lot.

Cell phones and other mobile devices are **not** permitted to be used in classrooms or in the hallways in ways other than directed by the teacher. **Making or receiving a phone call during class is a disciplinary offense and will be handled accordingly.** Students should respond to all requests to turn off devices and put them away. If a student fails to comply, devices will be confiscated and the parent will be required to visit the school to retrieve them. **Students are NOT permitted to bring cell phones or other electronic devices to school on days of Regents exam testing.**

Food and drinks are not permitted in classrooms.

Bicycles are to be locked in the available bike racks. They must be secured with a bicycle chain. There is no attendant to monitor this area.

All students are to be mindful of their own belongings. Students will not be permitted use of lockers during summer school.

All textbooks and devices loaned to students must be returned in good condition. Students will have to pay for lost or damaged materials.
