

Immunization Requirements for Students Entering School in September 2015

Dear Parent/Guardian,

Date:9/1/15

New York State Law Section 2164 mandates that schools shall not permit a child to be admitted to school without the required immunizations. Please be aware that the immunization schedule for certain vaccines have changed. The required immunizations are listed below.

Required Immunizations for Pre-Kindergarten

Immunization	Number of Doses
Polio	3
Hepatitis B	3
Diphtheria/Tetanus/Pertussis	4
Measles/Mumps/Rubella	1
Varicella (Chickenpox)	1
Hemophilus Influenzae	1 to 4
Pneumococcal Conjugate	1 to 4

Required Immunizations for Kindergarten

Immunization	Number of Doses
Polio	4
Hepatitis B	3*
Diphtheria/Tetanus/Pertussis	5*
Measles/Mumps/Rubella	2
Varicella (Chickenpox)	2

***MUST BE GIVEN AT CORRECT INTERVALS BASED ON AGE**

Acceptable proof of immunizations are as follows:

- An immunization certificate signed by your health care provider
- Immunization Registry report (NYSIIS or CIR from NYC) from your health care provider or your county health department
- A blood test (titer) lab report that proves your child is immune to a disease.
 - For varicella, a note from your health care provider (MD, NP, PA) which states your child had the disease is also acceptable.
