Water Testing Progress Report



Updated as of 6/9/2016

As you may know, there have been reports of lead being found in water from fountains and sinks in schools across the country, including on Long Island. Our goal in Oceanside is to safeguard the health and well-being of our students and staff by ensuring that the drinking water in our buildings is safe. Therefore, the Oceanside School District voluntarily began water quality testing in all of our schools in May.

The chart below is provided to communicate the most current information as it relates to the Oceanside UFSD.

School 2	Testing complete; awaiting lab results.
School 3	Testing complete; eight sources with minimally elevated levels of lead were removed and replaced. Re-testing of replacement units is complete; awaiting lab results.
School 4	Testing complete; no elevated levels of lead found.
School 5	Testing complete; awaiting lab results.
School 6/Castleton HS	Testing complete; awaiting lab results.
School 8	Testing complete; eight sources with minimally elevated levels of lead were removed and replaced. Re-testing of replacement units is complete; awaiting lab results.
Oceanside HS	Testing complete; awaiting lab results.
OMS/9E	Testing complete; awaiting lab results.
